1. Memorization of the entire Quran with proper Tajweed in 2-4 years

المؤهلات و شروط القبول في البرنامج للمستويات الثلاثة :

- (1) مستوى القراءة و مستوى التجويد يتم تحديدهما من خلال المقابلة و اختبار الطالب .
- (2) الاعمار التي يمكن قبولها في البرنامج من الصف 3 و حتى الصف 8 لكلا الجنسين .
- (3) يجب أن يكون الطالب حافظاً لجزء واحد على الأقل .
- (4) يطلب من الطالب خطاب مرجعي من مدرسته الحالية .
- (5) سيتم توقيع عقد بين الأطراف الثلاثة المعنية : الطالب / المعلم / ولي الأمر و ذلك لضمان التزام الطالب ببرنامج الحفظ الذي يتم الاتفاق عليه حسب مستوى الطالب .

Qualifications/Eligibility

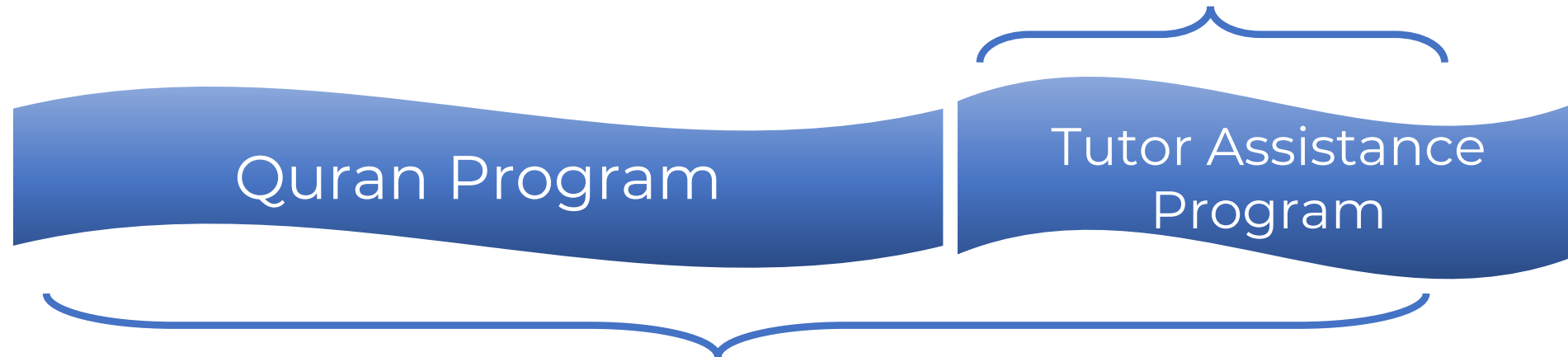


All 3 levels, the qualifications are:

1. Reading level will be assessed by the Examiner.
2. Tajweed level will be assessed by the Examiner.
3. Grades 3-8
4. Must have at least 1 Juzu' memorized
5. Reference letter from the students current school
6. A contract must be signed between teachers, students, and parents in order to commit to the amount of memorization that must be achieved

Academic Support

- ❖ Service
- ❖ Certified professional teachers, graduated in Edmonton
- ❖ Not accountable for achievement results
- ❖ Tools and manipulatives must be with the student to be able to assist (books, graphing calculators, geometry set.. Etc)
- ❖ These 2 hours are optional

5 Options to Enroll for Academic Learning

1. Public School via Online
2. Private School via Online
3. Argyll Online Learning
4. **Conseil scolaire Centre-Nord** ((CSCN)
5. Centre for Learning (CFL)

1. Public School

- Method of learning **Strictly** ** online learning **
- **Grades 1 to Grade 12**
- Online school for all core subjects (Math, Science, English, Social)
 - Any Public School
 - Must be enrolled within their online learning platform example Google Classroom.
 - Google classroom will be the platform through which the learning will be presented to the students.
 - The work will be submitted daily and or weekly.

TYPE	WHAT HAPPENS
Live online teacher instruction (synchronous learning)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning happens at a specific time of day• Students and teachers interact using virtual platforms such as Google Meet, Google Classroom and other secure Division applications• Students in Grades 1-12 have access to individual or small group instruction (scheduled meetings) where teachers monitor progress, complete assessments and provide feedback
Independent learning (asynchronous learning)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teacher assigns activities and students complete them throughout the day• Activities may include watching videos, writing on message boards or writing emails• Activity length depends on grade level

2.Private Schools

- Method of learning **Strictly** ** online learning **
- **Grades 1 to Grade 12**
- Online school for all core subjects (Math, Science, English, Social)
 - Can be enrolled in any private school
 - An Online platform will be used for students learning (example Google Classroom, Reminder, or Zoom).
 - The work will be submitted daily and or weekly.
 - Teachers will post daily videos of teaching

3. Argyll Online Learning

- Method of learning Strictly ** Parent Directed Learning **
- Grades 1 to Grade 12
- Please note: High school diplomas are not earned through a Parent-Directed high school program stream.
- **Parents have four key responsibilities:**
 - submit a home education plan (HEP) that meets the Home Education Regulation requirements
 - submit a mid and a year end written summary of the child's progress toward the learning outcomes
 - provide dated samples of the child's learning in all of the subject
 - attend student progress review meetings with the child twice yearly with the Argyll teacher

4. Conseil Scolaire Centre-Nord (CSCN)

- Method of learning **Strictly** ** Parent Directed Learning **
- **Grades 1 to Grade 12**
- Students will be tested twice a year
- \$835 grants (books, tools... etc) for both English and French curriculum
- You can also choose “ **Blended Method**” its for both teacher and parent taking accountability for teaching the child
- It can be from 1- several courses
- Students can contact teachers anytime through (email, phone call, whatsapp, or virtual platform)

5. Centre for Learning (CFL)

- *Christ Redmeer Catholic School*
- Method of learning *Strictly* ** Parent Directed Learning **
- **Grades 1 to Grade 12**
- Online school for all core subjects (Math, Science, English, Social)
- about \$1400 GRANTS to ensure students learning, you can buy computer, printer...etc)
- Make sure to choose all SUBJECTS to be through online
- Any assignment that could be about (another religion, or a holiday that you don't believe in can be omitted)
- Teachers are very flexible in terms of handing assignments in.
- Field Trips are many (mountains, forests, fishing, boats... etc)... you can choose which ones to attend... Also fees for field trips can be used from the grants
- Teachers will post daily videos of teaching
- Attendance to the virtual learning is NOT mandatory (however, you need to notify the school)

Centre for Learning (CFL) continues..

- Teachers available via email, telephone and online virtual platforms.
- Secure student and parent chat rooms promote positive peer relations and community building.
- Parental privileges: secure email, classroom access and learning resources.
- Daily prayer reflections (can be omitted)
- Alberta-wide curriculum focused events, workshops, field trips, etc.

COVID Procedure

- Maintain the two-meter physical distancing
- Classroom size 8-10 students per-class (spaced out)
- One teacher per class
- Students must be coming to school with their own mask
- We will provide hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes
- We will applying all the Alberta Health Services (AHS) guidelines
